Please note that all accommodation fees must be paid in full before check-in. Check-in time is after [14:00](#) and no later than [18:00](#). Should you be arriving later than [18:00](#) on day of check-in, please make the necessary arrangements. Check-out no later than [10:00](#) on day of departure, unless otherwise arranged.

Please take care of your vehicle and goods in transit as we do not take any responsibility for any damage or loss whatsoever.

Directions to Sunset Bush Camp. From O.R. Tambo International Airport, follow the R21 North towards Pretoria. Take the Polokwane, N1 North highway. Remember it is an E-Toll and Bakwena toll route. When you reach Hammanskraal off ramp, take the off ramp, pass through the Toll Gate. At the stop street, turn right. Drive for about 500m, then take the Rust de Winter road on the left. Continue on that road until you reach Tau Gate. When you enter Tau Gate, please take a ticket from the boom gate and keep it until you exit. Drive on the Rust de Winter road until you see Safari Mall on the left. Once you passed Safari Mall, you will go over a game grid. As you go over the grid, you then turn right on the De Wagens Drift road. You should not travel further than 6 km on the dirt road, you will find Dinokeng Wildernessway Gate on the right-hand side. When you reach the gate, please provide your booking details to security plus proof of conservation purchase. Once you enter the gate, keep left at the fork until you reach the crossing. Turn right at crossing and drive on that road for about 3km. You will see our entrance on the left. Turn left and drive another 300m. At the fork, keep right to reach our entrance.

There will be no exceptions to time of entry. Should you miss the timeline, you will have to travel around the park for entry.

Please drive safe on this road as there are lots of animals, hidden speed bumps and sharp turns on this road.

What to bring for your stay:

- Flash light is very important. We try and keep the light pollution to a minimum for star gazing.
- Additional blankets should you or your child be sleeping on single bed in a tent. There are no electric blankets on single beds. Due to COVID and water shortages, we cannot supply additional blankets.
- Own wine, beer, spirit and food.

Sunset Bush Camp does have a shop that supplies basic items:

- Colddrink (500ml & 2l)
- Chips, Biscuits, Rusks, Sweets & snacks

- Canned food
- Jan Pap, Rice, Soup powder, stock cubes, spices
- Coffee, cappachino saches, sugar and milk
- Insect repellent, insect killer
- Soap, tooth brushes, tooth paste and other sanitary goods
- Sunscreen, aftersun and pain tablets
- Wood, blits, ice and braai hardware

There are no set times for the shop. It will be opened on request.

- Swimming towels and toiletries. No Sunset Bush Camp towels will be allowed at the swimming pool.
- Sunscreen, medication, insect repellent, hat and warm jacket. Our weather is unpredictable and can get rather cold at night and very warm in the day.
- Binoculars, camera and chargers.
- Entertainment for kids.
- Natural coloured clothes for game drives and guided bush walks and please wear closed shoes for when it is dark.
- Firewood, charcoal and fire lighters will be sold on site. No Blue gum wood is allowed, as it sparks and is a risk for the thatch and veld fires. **No firewood is to be picked up from veld or broken from trees.**

Camp Rules and Other important information:

• **Right of admission reserved. Sunset Bush Camp or any of its employees do not accept any responsibility for any loss whatsoever.**

● **No Music. Absolute silence after 9PM.**

• Checkout time is **10:00AM**. Please adhere to the time. You are welcome to spend the rest of the day in the Game Reserve or at one of its picnic sites.

• Please respect another guests' privacy. As sound travels far at night in the bush, please keep noise to minimum and enjoy the night sounds of the Bushveld.

• Should there be any damages to the property, equipment, furniture or linen, you will be held liable for the repair or replacement thereof.

• Please take care of your children (Especially around the unfenced swimming pool).

• High voltage electric fence (10 000V). We need to keep the people inside in some or other way.

• Venomous snakes (Mozambique spitting cobra, Snouted cobra, Black Mamba, Boomslang, Puff adder and many more).

- Spiders, scorpions and bees.
- I don't care how familiar you are with venomous creatures, please do not try and catch or handle them.
- Lion, elephant, leopard, rhino, buffalo and hippos.
- Keep your chalet door closed and tent flysheets zipped up for insects, snakes and lizards.
- We take nothing from the bush but memories and photographs and leave nothing but foot prints.
- Please do not take any wood from the ground or out of trees. It is a protected area and the nutrients need to go back into the echo system.
- Please put your fire out every night with the bucket water supplied, as the wind could cause a spark to be blown on to the grass and cause a huge fire. Should you not have a bucket of water for some reason, please do not hesitate to enquire.
- There is always a very high risk of veld fires in the Bushveld. Please take care if you are a smoker. Make sure you put your cigarette out and dispose of the butts properly. No smoking inside any of the chalets, tents or communal areas.
- There is a lot of Tree Agama's inside the fenced off area. Try not to disturb them.
- When you go on a Game Drive or trails, please adhere to all the rules and listen to the Field Guide. No smoking while on a game drive. You may get permission to smoke once you get off the vehicle.
- No breaking of trees or branches or collecting wood from the veld for any purpose what so ever.
- No walking outside the fenced off area without the guide.
- No people hanging out of windows or sunroofs of vehicles or on back of bakkies.
- No littering.
- No standing up on the Game Viewer, hanging over the side or limbs hanging out.
- No getting out or off the vehicle unless in a designated area or instructed by the Field Guide.
- No music allowed.
- No DRUGS!
- No misbehaving.
- Please note that we have a septic tank. Please ensure to place all non-biodegradable material in the dustbins and not too flush it down the toilet.
- Please take care of the facility and linen as if it was your own.

Please note that we are rehabilitating any spoilt areas inside the camp. We have decided to remove all alien grass and plants and re-establish natural accuring vegetation and trees.

Should you see something like this in your room or your bed, please do not worry. It is normal as it is Gecko scat. They are employed to get rid of some of the mosquito and flies in your room. We are in the bush after all, so you can expect to come closer to nature.

DINOKENG GAME RESERVE / SUNSET BUSH CAMP Indemnity

I acknowledge that I am well acquainted with and fully aware of the real danger and risks that are associated with game reserves and / or game lodges and / or game viewing, arising from the presence of wild and dangerous animals, reptiles, birds and insects and the real risk of bodily harm, injury, death and / or damage to property which may arise as a result of an encounter with the aforementioned creatures, and / or the particular circumstances prevailing on a game reserve or game drive or a game reserve environment. More particularly:

a) There may not always be protection in the form of fences, buildings and vehicles in which to take cover in potentially dangerous circumstances and that hazards such as potentially dangerous animals; including Elephant, Hyena, Buffalo, Rhinoceros, Leopard, Hippo, Crocodile and general antelope species as well as venomous snakes, spiders, insects and plants may be encountered in the game reserve.

b) Rivers and dams contain Hippo, Crocodile and possibly Bilharzia. Bodily entry into such waters is strictly prohibited.

c) Serious sunburn and heat exhaustion may result from unprotected exposure, directly or indirectly, to the sun and heat. Care must be taken for adequate protection and fluids to be drunk.

I hereby voluntarily assume the risk inherent in visiting the game reserve, as well as participating in activities such as going on walks, drives and boat activities, whether on an unsupervised and unaccompanied basis or not.

I further acknowledge that I shall, entirely at my own risk, have to travel a distance through the game reserve before I reach a lodge, camp, access to self-drive route or other service provider.

I hereby indemnify and hold harmless and free, the managers, landowners and product owners of the DINOKENG GAME RESERVE, their associates, agents, representatives, servants and employees against all injury, loss or damage which I may sustain from any cause arising as a result of having entered an area containing game, whether arising from an act or omission on their part. This includes any and all claims of whatsoever nature which may arise on behalf of my dependants and / or persons accompanying me upon entering the game reserve.

The DINOKENG GAME RESERVE may at its discretion and without prejudice and without admission of liability arrange emergency medical treatment for and on behalf of any guest.

I furthermore acknowledge that it is a condition of admission that guests with children accept full responsibility for the actions and safety of the children under their control. The nature of a game reserve, a game lodge and its camps are such that it is potentially dangerous for children, and guardians are expected to control their children to prevent them from harming themselves or inconveniencing other guests.
